Remark:	It is the organizer's intention to bid in November 2012 for hosting the 2014 World Parachuting Championship (WPC) in PARA-SKI at the same venue as this event. If this bid from Germany will be accepted by the IPC, the 2013 competition will be a perfect preparation for participating in the WPC 2014.

Schedule:

Wednesday, 20th, Feb. 2013:

Official arrival until 2200 hrs: arrival and registration (to include payment of entry fee)
Training jumps are possible from 1330 h

Thursday, 21st, Feb. 2013:

Until 1000 hrs: latest arrival and registration (to include payment of entry fee)
1030 hrs: 1st team leader meeting
1300 hrs: Start of competition / Ski Race or Accuracy landing

Friday, 22nd, Feb. 2013:

From 0900 hrs: Continuation of competition / Accuracy landing or Ski Race

Saturday, 23rd, Feb. 2013:

From 0900 hrs: Continuation of competition / Accuracy landing
Approx. 1900 hrs: Official dinner

Sunday, 24th, Feb. 2013:

From 0900 hrs: Continuation of competition / Accuracy landing
NLT 1500 hrs: End of competition

- Awards ceremony will be held right after completion of the Competition

Entry fee:

€ 540 per competitor including:
Organization; 6 competition jumps incl. re-jumps and tie-break jumps;
use of ski lift; 4 times lunch and 3 times dinner (starting on 21st Feb.),
4 times accomodation; double bed occupancy (starting 20th Feb.) in ****SportsHotel
€15 per jump will be refunded for uncompleted rounds.
For training jumps are to pay € 30.00 per jump

€ 360 per accompanying person, including:
Organization; use of ski lift; 4 times lunch and 3 times dinner (starting on 21st Feb.),
4 times accomodation; double bed occupancy (starting 20th Feb.) in ****SportsHotel

Competition rules:

- see regulations to the EC 2013 at www.paraski.org
- Competitors must hold a current parachuting license, third party liability insurance and personal accident insurance.
- German championships will be ruled according to the EC regulation 2013 at www.paraski.org

Composition of team:

Teams of four; individual competitors allowed; all scores will count towards the individual AND the team classification.

Competition 1:

Six (min. two) rounds of accuracy landing.
Electronic measurement up to 15 cm with a dead center of **2 cm**, beyond this hand measurement up to 50 cm.

Competition 2:

Two runs of giant slalom on ski or snowboard.
Only start in a possible discipline (ski or board)

- Final round:** The best eight male and the best four female (if there is a separate women's ranking) competitors of the German Championship individual ranking.
- Ranking:**
- Combined rankings of Competitions 1 and 2
 - At least five teams are required for a valid team ranking;
 - A minimum participation of five competitors each is required to score men's, women's, junior and master individual rankings.
 - A minimum participation of five competitors/teams is required to score German Championships individual and team rankings (women and men).
- Snowboarding:**
- Minimum of two competitors.
 - Same course as ski giant slalom.
 - Unofficial male (female) German Champion.
- Protest fee:** €50,00
- Liability:** The organizer does not cover liability for any damage or accident caused by the participants as this is beyond our responsibility as organizer of the above events.

We hope that this event will attract many athletes and a plenty of audience.

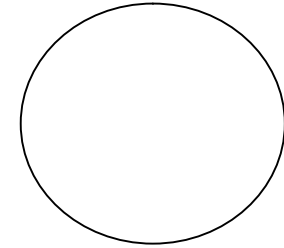
